

# Nematodes



## For the control of Vine Weevil

As the first berries are picked from June bearing strawberries, adult vine weevil emerge and after a month begin to lay their eggs. As these hatching larvae are small, resultant damage will appear minimal and the level of forthcoming risk underestimated.

FAST highly recommend starting applications of the nematode *Heterorhabditis bacteriophora* from early August, to be reapplied at least once every 4 weeks.

Using the correct nematode for the soil temperature is key, so FAST recommend Nematop® which is active at soil temperatures above 12°C, ideally above 14°C for at least 8 hours in the day.
